

Let's work to keep each other safe!





WALK & TALK eniors GROUP

Walk and Talk is a program, developed by Dr Charlotte Jones, of UBCO, to meet the identified needs of seniors for socialization, physical fitness and health education. The program consists of three parts: a half hour walk in historic downtown Kelowna, a half hour of exercises developed by the University of Otaga in New Zealand, designed specifically to strengthen the muscles that are most useful in improving balance and preventing falls; and a time for socialization. Everyone walks at their own pace with whatever mobility aids they are most comfortable using. The exercises improve your mobility, balance, and muscle strengthen. There is an increasing body of knowledge concerning the health risks associated with social isolation. The group chooses the topics for the discussion time. We will start the program mid September and meet twice a week eight to ten weeks. This program is designed for seniors of all physical abilities. Please consider joining us.

We are so grateful for Susanne Marentette's connection with the Lake Country Food Bank and the wonderful donations we receive from them: vegetables, fruit and bakery items each week and occasionally eggs, milk and yogurt. Plus, we also get produce from our own garden! These extra offerings are very much appreciated by our guests.

We are also very grateful to all of those who bring in groceries to help in the food pantry. Every can or box we receive helps fill another grocery bag for someone in need.

As you can imagine, with 50+ people to feed, we need a lot of food. We thank the individuals who make sandwiches for us to distribute each week, those who bake cookies and make the wonderful desserts we receive, and those who bring in soup, chili, salads, casseroles, etc. for the lunches. These contributions are enjoyed so much by our guests that I cannot begin to thank you in the many ways that they thank us. Our guests love the chicken that is donated by KFC (so I must thank them as well!) but they really love a home-cooked meal and they appreciate the fact that someone took the time to make something just for them. Your generosity and caring do not go unnoticed by our guests.

And lastly, a big thank you to our shoppers and to all of the volunteers who show up on Tuesday morning to serve our guests. You are a devoted and caring group of individuals and Outreach would not be possible without you.




